

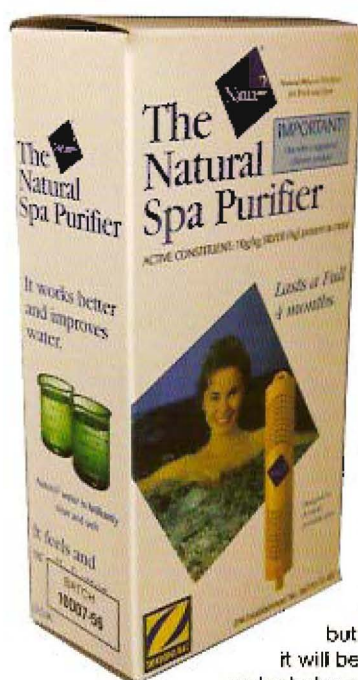
Zodiac Nature² Spa Purifier & Poppits Spa Sanitiser Q & A



How does the Nature² Spa Purifier work?

The Nature² Spa Purifier is a natural compound water treatment system. Its action is based on water passing through a cartridge, which contains a ceramic bed impregnated with minerals (Silver and Zinc). These minerals fight a continuous battle in your spa against the bacteria, algae and viruses which can develop in the water.

What are the benefits of a Nature² Spa Purifier together with Poppit Spa Sanitiser?



Using a Nature² Spa Purifier together with Poppit Spa Sanitiser will improve the look, feel, and smell of your spa water dramatically. You'll discover the joy of crystal clear water, free of stickiness and odors chlorine and bromine can cause. With this combination you can eliminate the discomfort of eye and skin irritations and simplify the balancing of water. The Nature² purifier is unaffected by heat, and discourages scum lines around your spa.

With Nature² will spa maintenance be different?

Yes. Nature² Spa Purifier reduces the need for Poppit Spa Sanitiser and general upkeep. The water is controlled and cleaned as before, but the filter will stay a lot cleaner and it will be much easier to obtain the right water balance.

Is there anything that affects the life of the Nature² Spa Purifier?

No. Filtration time, intensive use, high temperatures, none of these things effect the life or efficiency of the cartridge, which remains active for 4 months in any private spa.

Where is the Nature² Spa Purifier located on my spa system?

It is located on the spa filter. The Nature² Spa Purifier just slips into your spa filter, where it works twenty four hours a day to keep your spa water clean.

When do I replace the Nature² Spa Purifier?

The Nature² Spa Purifier must be replaced every 4 months to work effectively.

How do I dispose of my Nature² Spa Purifier?

It is safe for disposal with other household garbage.

Is Nature² Spa Purifier a filter?

No. A filter's job is to remove dirt and impurities. Nature² Spa Purifier cleans the water by destroying bacteria, algae and viruses that are too small to be caught by the filter. You need a combination of the two, a filter plus Nature² Spa, with the filter working exactly the same as it would without the nature² spa.

Is the Nature² spa Purifier affected by the spas temperature?

No, unlike chlorine and bromine, the Nature² Spa Purifier with Poppit Spa Sanitiser is unaffected by the spa temperatures.

Can Nature² spa purifier stain my spa?

No. Nature² Spa Purifier minerals remain well below levels that might cause staining. In fact, Nature² offers a "no stain" warranty.

Can I use bromine, sodium bromine or bioguanides?

No. Under no circumstances should the Nature² Spa Purifier be used with these chemicals. If such chemicals are used with your Nature² Spa Purifier it is essential that you empty the spa completely and fill it with fresh water.

How often do I need to super-chlorinate (shock)?

There is no need to use chlorine shock at all – continue to use Poppit Quick Fix weekly for high use spas and fortnightly for average spas, (to burn off any organic matter), at the rate of 30 grams per 1,000 litres. If the water turns cloudy, use 60 grams of Quick Fix and filter for up to 4 hours with the cover off the spa.

Are the minerals safe, even in small quantities?

The minerals used with Nature² Spa purifier are absolutely no threat to health, because they are used in tiny concentrations which never under any circumstances increase.

But do I still need to use chlorine?

No. Poppit Spa Sanitiser works so as to disinfect the water in synergy with the minerals provided by nature² spa, providing control of both bacteria and algae at the same time.
